4 HIGH RISK: Undertaking TCL, Undertaking-Resignation, Discipline

The public interest depends on the integrity of the profession.

Protecting the integrity of the profession demands zero tolerance of inappropriate business practices.

Inappropriate Business Practices may include, but are not limited to:

- Conflict of interest
- Creating false records
- Fraud
- Lack of transparency in records
- Providing unnecessary services
- Billing for a service as something it is not

- Practicing outside of scope
- Inappropriate use of physiotherapist assistants
- Lack of supervision
- Fees for referrals
- Billing for services not rendered

Sexual Abuse

"sexual abuse" of a patient by a member means,

- (a) sexual intercourse or other forms of physical sexual relations between the member and the patient—MANDATORY REVOCATION
- (b) touching, of a sexual nature, of the patient by the member—POTENTIAL MANDATORY REVOCATION
- (c) behaviour or remarks of a sexual nature by the member towards the patient

Scope of Practice

The practice of physiotherapy is the assessment of neuromuscular, musculoskeletal and cardio respiratory systems, the diagnosis of diseases or disorders associated with physical dysfunction, injury or pain and the treatment, rehabilitation and prevention or relief of physical dysfunction, injury or pain to develop, maintain, rehabilitate or augment function and promote mobility.
